### REDUNDANT SEWER FORCE MAIN PROJECT

#### Construction & Updated Traffic Advisory

The City of Fort Lauderdale continues to work with David Mancini & Sons to construct a portion of a new 7.5 mile sewer transmission line to create redundancy, enhance reliability, and improve services for neighbors.

The underground directional drilling on SE 9 Avenue is nearing completion. From 7 a.m., Friday, May 22, until approximately 7 p.m., Sunday, May 24, the contractor plans to work 24-hours-a-day to install the new sewer pipe. Continuous 24-hour operation is necessary to successfully pull the new pipe through the underground pathway. Neighbors should anticipate noise in the area while the pipe is installed.

After the pipe is pulled, the contractor will resume a Monday to Saturday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. schedule; they will also reopen several streets along SE 9 Avenue as shown in the enclosed map. The new traffic advisory will remain in effect approximately three months.

We apologize for any inconvenience and thank our neighbors for their continued patience as we work to install the new pipe as quickly as possible.
