REDUNDANT SEWER FORCE MAIN PROJECT

Update on Rio Vista and Harbordale Road Closures

The City of Fort Lauderdale continues to work with David Mancini & Sons to construct a portion of a new 7.5 mile sewer transmission line to create redundancy, enhance reliability, and improve services for neighbors.

As work progresses, the contractor will expand the closures along SE 9 and SE 10 Avenue. On May 9, the following road closures will begin to go into effect:

- There will be no access across SE 9 Avenue between SE 6 Court and SE 12 Street.
- There will be no access across SE 10 Avenue between SE 12 Street and SE 15 Street.

The road closures are necessary so that SE 9 Avenue can be utilized as a staging area for 2,500 feet of pipe that will be pulled from SE 9 Avenue and SE 7 Street north under the New River to SE 9 Avenue and 2 Court. In addition, the closures will allow a section of pipe to be installed under SE 10 Avenue from SE 15 Street to SE 12 Street.

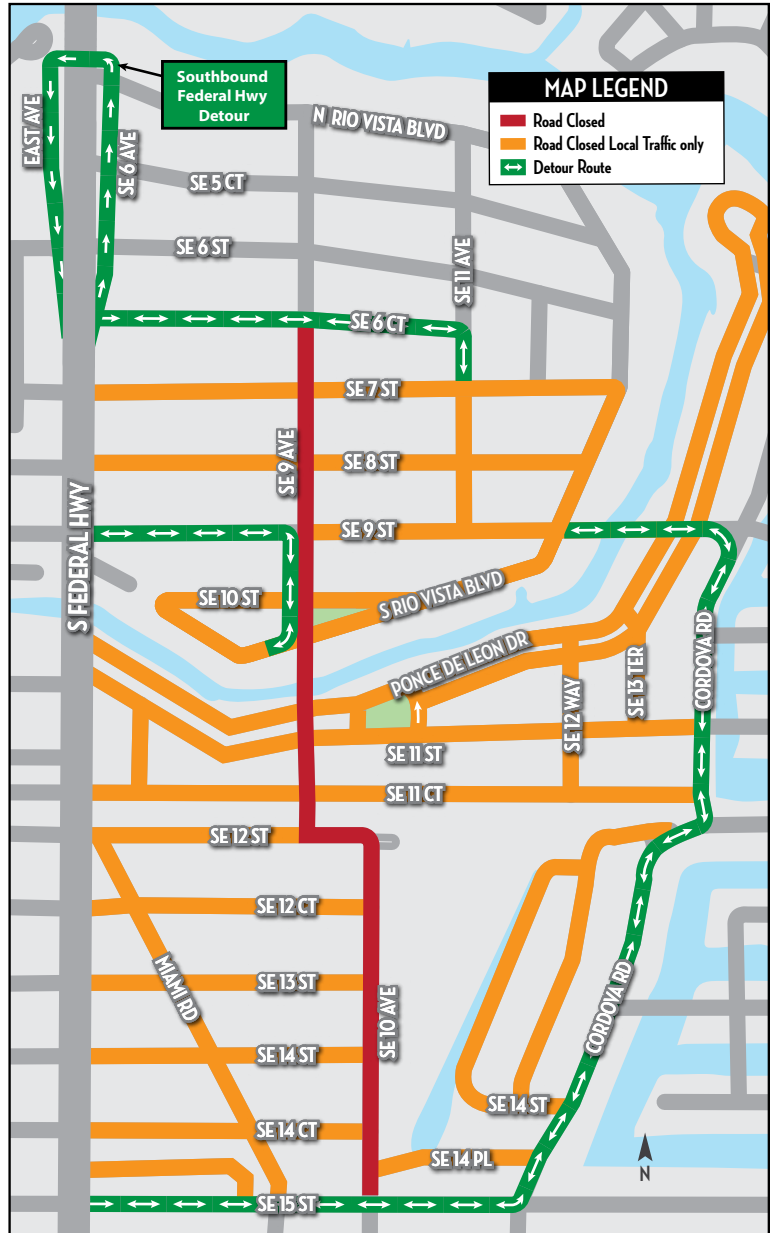
Work will take place daily from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. The contractor will work with neighbors to maintain access to individual properties. Work in Rio Vista, on SE 9 Avenue, is expected to take four weeks. Neighbors who live east of SE 9 Avenue should use Cordova Road. Neighbors west of SE 9 Avenue should use Federal Highway. Work in Harbordale, on SE 10 Avenue, is expected to take three months.

Please drive with caution. We appreciate your patience as we strive to upgrade our sewer system as quickly as possible.
