RVCA Secretary's Update- June 2017

On June 12, 2017 we had two Civic Association meetings back-to-back which were open to all residents. We started off with the Special Meeting where the topic was security and the guests were Chief Maglione, Commander Dodson, and Captain Scelfo. With regards to our neighborhood we learned that when comparing statistics from April 2016 & 2017, Part 1 crimes in our area are down by over 50% in Rio Vista. We were again reminded to call the security patrol detail number to report any and all neighborhood concerns. The update on the recent efforts to increase membership in the security patrol was that it generated 100 new members. Chief Maglione discussed a change in direction of the Department and answered a wide range of audience questions. Here are some of the more discussed topics:

- FLPD is increasing traffic enforcement & working more aggressively to prevent crime.
- The Body Worn Camera pilot program should begin in late summer 2017.
- In 2018 the Department is hoping to add a DUI & Aggressive Driving Unit.
- FLPD is aware of the traffic issues surrounding Starbucks at Federal Highway & Davie Boulevard. It was pointed out that the business is legally permitted to operate, is the highest ranking drive thru in the region, and that the previously placed mobile traffic sign has to be used throughout our City. It should be noted that at Romney Roger's Pre-Agenda meeting on 6/19/2017 he advised that his office was going to request the mobile sign be placed near the Starbucks once a month.

After the special meeting we continued onto our General Meeting where current Commissioner Romney Rogers was in attendance and addressed the attendees. Additionally, we were introduced to the following candidates in our upcoming local election: Bruce Roberts, Charlotte Rodstrom, Walter Duke, & Dr. Ben Sorensen.
