



SEWER PIPE MAINTENANCE: RIO VISTA AREA ALONG PART OF US-1 Infrastructure Improvements Coming to Your Community

The City of Fort Lauderdale is working with LMK Pipe Renewal to perform maintenance on an 8-inch sewer line along the far east lane of northbound US-1 between Davie Boulevard and Ponce De Leon Drive. Work is scheduled to take place from January 3, 2022 to March 1, 2022, between the hours of 9 p.m. - 4 a.m. Monday through Friday. All affected homes and businesses will remain fully accessible.

In addition, on a few of these days, the east side of the US-1 and SE 11th Court intersection will also need to be temporarily closed. The roadways will be open and fully accessible on January 17, 2021 for Martin Luther King Jr. Day.

Closures:

- The far east lane of northbound US-1 between Davie Boulevard and Ponce de Leon Drive will be closed.
- The east side of the intersection of US-1 and SE 11th Court will intermittently be closed.

Detours:

- Northbound traffic on US-1 will be detoured east at Ponce de Leon Drive to SE 6th Terrace to provide full access to the area.
